In Sheet Metal, Electrical, Plumbing, Pipefitting, or Electronic Systems Technician (EST)

Apprenticeship is a three to five-year program of on-the-job training and related classroom instruction. After successfully completing an apprenticeship program, you will graduate as a State and Federally recognized craftsperson in your chosen craft.

Follow these **5** easy steps

APPLICATION

Complete an ABC application to register for the next written entrance test of basic math and reading skills. Applicants must be 18 or older and provide proof of a High School Diploma, GED or equivalent. Electrical applicants must also include proof of completion of a basic algebra course with a "C" or better. **Visit www.abcsd.org for an application.**

WRITTEN COMPETENCY TEST

On your scheduled test day, present a picture/photo ID in order to test. You must pass both the Reading and Math sections to advance to the next step in the selection process.

ORAL INTERVIEW

After passing the written entrance test, you will be scheduled for an oral interview with the apprenticeship committee.

REGISTRATION & MANDATORY DRUG TEST

At the enrollment step, you will attend orientation and complete your apprenticeship and school forms. All applicants must pass a drug test prior to final acceptance into the program. Electrical and EST applicants must also pass a color vision screening.

EMPLOYMENT & TRAINING PROCESS

As an ABC apprentice, you will work for an ABC member contractor and receive paid on-the-job training. You will also attend school, typically two nights per week, to complete your theory and technical classroom requirements. You will earn college credits from the San Diego Community College District for each course you complete. Tuition for all apprenticeship classes is waived. Apprentices are responsible for purchasing textbooks and tools.
