

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. APPLICATION.

Complete an ABC application to register for the next written entrance test of basic math and reading skills. Applicants must be 18 or older and provide proof of a High School Diploma, GED or equivalent. Electrical applicants must also include proof of completion of a basic algebra course with a "C" or better. **Apply today at www.abcsd.org/apprenticeship-application**

2. WRITTEN COMPETENCY TEST.

On your scheduled test day, present a picture/photo ID in order to test. You must pass both the Reading and Math sections to advance to the next step in the selection process.

3. INTERVIEW.

After passing the written entrance test, you will be scheduled for an oral interview with the apprenticeship committee.

4. REGISTRATION & MANDATORY DRUG TEST.

At the enrollment step, you will attend orientation and complete your apprenticeship and school forms. All applicants must pass a drug test prior to final acceptance into the program. Electrical and EST applicants must also pass a color vision screening.

5. EMPLOYMENT & TRAINING PROCESS

As an ABC apprentice, you will work for an ABC member contractor and receive paid on-the-job training. You will also attend school, typically two nights per week, to complete your theory and technical classroom requirements. You will earn college credits for each course you complete. Tuition for all apprenticeship classes is waived. Apprentices are responsible for purchasing textbooks and tools.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Have a High School Diploma, GED or High School Equivalency
 - Electrical Trade Only: Proof of completing an algebra class with a "C" grade or better
- Be able to legally work in the United States
- Have reliable personal transportation
