**APPRENTICESHIP** programs provide a unique combination of paid on-the-job work experience and classroom instruction. These programs require the applicant to have a High School Diploma or GED and a passing score on an entrance test.

Programs offered through the San Diego Associated Builders and Contractors require the following score levels on the TABE entrance test:

	Reading Grade Level	Math Grade Level
Plumbing/ Pipefitting	8.0	8.0
Sheet Metal	8.0	10.0
*Electrical/ EST	10.0	9.6

\*Electrical apprentices must also show that they have completed an Algebra course with a grade of “C” or higher. Algebra credit may be earned at many of the continuing education learning centers listed on page two of this flyer.
